





A Important



Read this entire installation manual to ensure proper installation. When finished with the installation, file this manual with the owner or maintenance department. Compliance and conformity to local codes and ordinances is the responsibility of the installers.



Separate parts from packaging and make sure all parts are accounted for before discarding any packaging material. If any parts are missing, do not begin installation until all parts are obtained.



Make sure that all water supply lines have been flushed and completely turned off before starting the installation. Debris in supply lines can cause valves to malfunction.



Turn off electrical power to the electrical outlets, then unplug units prior to installation. Electrical power MUST remain off until installation is complete.



Installers hardware must be appropriate for wall construction. Wall anchors and mounting fasteners MUST have a minimum pull-out rating of 1,000 lbs for 3/8" hole.



For standard height mounting, DO NOT exceed the recommended 34 inch distance from the top of the sink deck to the finished floor. To meet ADA requirements the sink deck cannot not exceed the 34 inch maximum height dimension.



Wear all proper safety equipment prior to installation

- Electric drill for drilling anchor holes
- Standard sockets, basin wrench, and open end wrench set for installing anchoring fasteners and faucets
- Pipe wrench for installing drain lines
- Phillips and straight blade screwdrivers
- Tubing cutter

- Carpenter's square

- Caulk gun
- 1/2" NPT hot/cold or tempered supply piping
- 1 1/2" NPT drain piping including p-trap
- Adhesive: Loctite® PL Premium® FAST GRAB Polyurethane Construction Adhesive, or equivalent
- 110 volt GFCI protected electrical outlet for 100-120 VAC plug-in transformer
- Screen filter(s) included with faucet(s)
- Backing supplied by others to meet local codes

Prior to Installation

CAUTION:

Adequate structural support in or behind the wall is required. Refer to the appropriate rough-in diagram for dry weight of sink. All electrical wiring is to be installed in accordance with national/local codes and regulations. Electrical outlets should be recessed and installed prior to installation.

All plumbing should be installed in accordance with applicable codes and regulations.

Before connecting flex hoses to supply stops, flush all water lines until water is clear.


Hot and cold water supply lines/tempered supply line and drain lines. Recommended to have Control Stops on water supply lines in place prior to installation.





1. Install Backing (Figure 2) onto wall studs.

Note: Backing supplied by others to meet local codes.

- a. If drywall is present, refer to rough-in, Figure 1, and cut out drywall window to the outer dimension of the side brackets and 12 1/2" high, 33" above finished floor.
- b. Remove drywall window.
- c. Pre-drill/cut holes for plumbing and electrical.
- d. Install backing into cutout drywall window.
- 2. Mount the Side Brackets (2, Figure 2) to the backing. Ensure that Side Brackets (2) are level and the proper distance from the floor.

Note: Anchor side brackets to wall using 1,000 lb pull out mounting fasteners for 3/8" holes (not supplied).

a. Using mounting fasteners secure Side Brackets (2) onto backing, making sure that the top of Side Brackets (2) are 33 inches above finished floor. (ADA specifications)v







- b. Remove drywall window.
- c. Pre-drill/cut holes for plumbing and electrical.
- d. Install backing into cutout drywall window.
- 6. Mount the Side and Middle Brackets (2, 3, Figure 6) to the backing. Ensure that Side and Middle Brackets (2, 3) are level and the proper distance from the floor.

Note: Anchor side brackets to wall using 1,000 lb pull out mounting fasteners for 3/8" holes (not supplied).





- 10. Mount the Side and Middle Brackets (2, 3, Figure 10) to the backing. Ensure that Side and Middle Brackets (2, 3) are level and the proper distance from the floor.










