Equipped with hands-free, sensor-operated technology, <u>Sloan's mobile handwashing stations</u> are designed to enable more convenient handwashing options placed anywhere inside or outside a building where hygiene is essential.

Sloan's mobile handwashing stations are available as self-contained water or water lineconnected handwashing stations. All five available models include a sensor-operated paper towel dispenser and a wall-mounted foam soap dispenser. Additionally, each station is equipped with a 16-gallon greywater tank, and select models have a hot water heater or two five-gallon water jugs.
